

# CHAPTER 9

## 9.1 Command Rules: tú, usted, ustedes

### Command Rules

#### Tú, usted, and ustedes commands:

A. When the command is “do” affirmative:

- To form the **tú command**, use the **third person singular present tense** form of the **-ar, -er, -ir** verb.

Example:

Infinitive	Tú Command
hablar	habla
correr	corre
abrir	abre

- To form the **usted command**, change the **tú command**.

- If the **tú command** is **a** change to an **e**.
- If the **tú command** is **e** change to **a**.

Examples:

Infinitive	Tú Command	Usted Command
hablar	habla	hable
correr	corre	corra
abrir	abre	abra

- To form the **ustedes command**, add **n** to the **usted** command.

Examples:

Infinitive	Tú Command	Usted Command	Ustedes Command
hablar	habla	hable	hablen
correr	corre	corra	corran
abrir	abre	abra	abran

- All the **-ar, -er, -ir** verbs that have changes in the vowel of the stem in the present tense (**stem-changing verbs**), have these same changes for the **tú, usted, and ustedes** commands.

Examples:

Infinitive	Tú Command	Usted Command	Ustedes Command
cerrar	cierra	cierre	cierren
perder	pierde	pierda	pierdan
servir	sirve	sirva	sírvan
dormir	duerme	duerma	duerman
encontrar	encuentra	encuentre	encuentren
volver	vuelve	vuelva	vuelvan
mentir	miente	mienta	mientan

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**B.** When the command is “don’t” negative:

1. Negative **tú** form = **no + usted form of the command + s**
2. Negative **usted** form = **no + usted form of the command**
3. Negative **ustedes** form = **no + ustedes form of the command**

Application of the negative command:

Infinitive	Tú Command	Usted Command	Ustedes Command
hablar	no hables	no hable	no hablen
correr	no corras	no corra	no corran
abrir	no abras	no abra	no abran

**C.** There are some **verbs** that have **irregular command forms**:

Model: Infinitive (*Tú* command - *Usted* command)

tener (ten-tenga)	oír (oye-oiga)	ir (ve-vaya)	traer (trae-traiga)
venir (ven-venga)	valer (vale-valga)	ver (ve-vea)	caer (cae-caiga)
decir (di-diga)	salir (sal-salga)	ser (sé-sea)	saber (sabe-sepa)
hacer (haz-haga)	poner (pon-ponga)	seguir (sigue-siga)	cocer (cuece-cueza)
conducir (conduce-conduzca)		conocer (conoce-conozca)	

**D.** There are **verbs** that will change in the *usted* column to maintain the sound:

Model: Infinitive (*Tú* command - *Usted* command)

Any verb that has the same ending **must change** in the **usted command**.

buscar (busca - busque)	cruzar (cruza-cruce)	escoger (escoge-escoja)	infligir (inflige – inflija)	llegar (llega-llegue)
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#### E. Commands of Reflexive Verbs

**1. Affirmative Commands of Reflexive Verbs:** The reflexive pronouns **follow** the commands and are **attached** to them. Remember, the reflexive pronoun must correspond with the subject. Do not forget to add an accent, when it is needed.

Examples:

Infinitive	Tú Command	Usted Command	Ustedes Command
bañarse	báñate	báñese	báñense
vestirse	vístete	vístase	vístanse
ponerse	póntete	póngase	pónganse

**2. Negative Commands of Reflexive Verbs:** The **reflexive** pronouns are placed **before** the commands and they must correspond with the subject.

Examples:

Infinitive	Tú Command	Usted Command	Ustedes Command
bañarse	no <b>te</b> bañes	no <b>se</b> bañe	no <b>se</b> bañen
vestirse	no <b>te</b> vistas	no <b>se</b> vista	no <b>se</b> vistan
ponerse	no <b>te</b> pongas	no <b>se</b> ponga	no <b>se</b> pongan

## 9.2 -AR, -ER, -IR Verbs with Regular Command Forms

1. To form the **tú command**, use the **third person singular present tense** form of the **-ar, -er, -ir** verb.
2. To form the **usted command**, change the **tú** command.
  - If the **tú** command is **a** change to an **e**.
  - If the **tú** command is **e** change to **a**.
3. To form the negative **tú command**, use the **usted command** form and add **-s**.
