# Tú y Usted en Español

¿Observas que en español hay unas expresiones formales y unas expresiones que no son formales? Algunos verbos terminan con la **-s y otros en -a or -e**.

## En el español, hay dos maneras de decir “you” – TÚ y USTED.

- **Use Tú** . . . when you are talking to one person (**singular**) who you know very well (**informal**.) Even if you don’t see the exact word “tú” in the expression, you still have a more relaxed way of talking to a friend, family member, pet, or plant!
- **Use USTED** . . . when you are talking to an adult you don’t know well (**formal**). This could be a friend of your parents, a waitress, a salesperson, or the president. It is important to show proper respect when speaking Spanish. Many Spanish teachers expect that you will speak to them formally, but American teachers are more casual. *If you are ever in doubt, use “Usted.”*
- **Use USTEDES** . . . when you are talking to more than one person (**plural**), even if you know them very well. Like “tú”, you won’t necessarily see the word when speaking in a plural way.

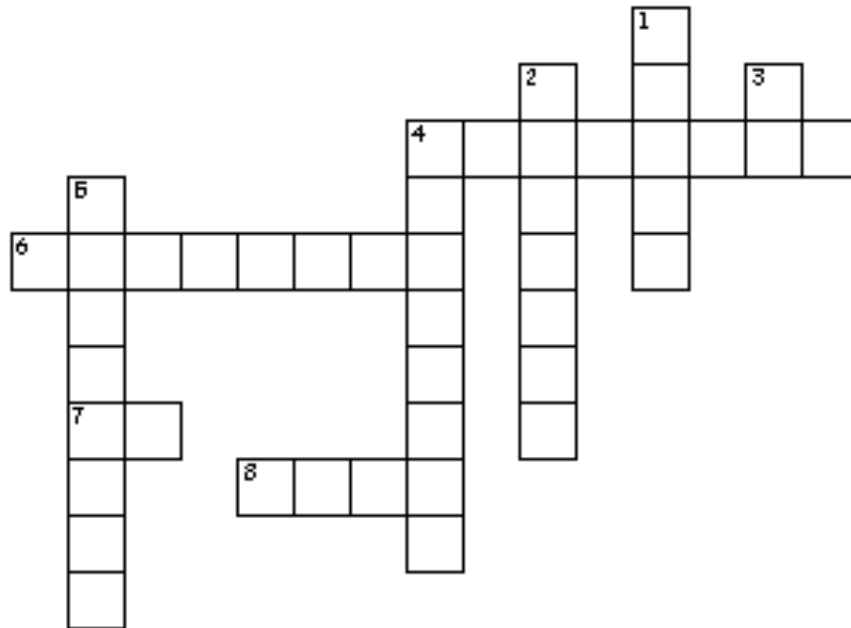
